Greetings from Sharjah Indian School......

The Sharjah Private Education Authority in cooperation with the Crisis and Emergency Committee of the Emirate of Sharjah has announced Face to Face mode of education mandatory for all the students in Sharjah schools.

In this context you are hereby informed well in advance to make the necessary arrangements as we will be gradually making 100% Face to Face mode of education compulsory. Hence from 19th October 2021, Grade VI to XII will have 100% Face to Face mode of education only. There will be no online education and hybrid mode of learning. Please make the necessary arrangements accordingly.

Parents of students using school transport are requested to update the transport details of their ward with the transport department and pay the transport fees accordingly.

In case of any unavoidable medical conditions of the student, you can contact the undersigned for ways and means.

Please note the following:

- All the students (12 years and above, that is from Grade VI to XII) should wear mask, gloves and carry with them a small bottle of sanitizer.
- Students should strictly follow the social distancing norms.
- The capacity of the school bus is 100% now, but proper self-hygiene has to be followed by the student.
- Students should attend the classes in proper school uniform.
- There will not be canteen facility in the school. The students are required to bring their own snacks, lunch and water which should not be shared with anybody.
- You are requested to update your ward with the latest Covid-19 protocols of the country which has to be followed . while in the school campus and the school bus.
- Please do not send your ward to school in case he / she has any symptoms of Covid-19.

All the students vaccinated or not vaccinated can attend Face to Face classes in school. But we strongly recommend you to vaccinate your ward to ensure a high degree of safety and security of your ward.

We expect utmost cooperation from your end being our partner in the schooling process of your ward.
