CAREER COUNSELLING AND GUIDANCE POLICIES

> AIM – FOCUSING ON STUDENT EMPOWERMENT

Career guidance is considered a crucial part of schooling due to its essential role in preparing students for the future. > GUIDANCE SESSIONS – ENCOURAGING THE STUDENTS
