The following activities are aimed at creating an awareness about the responsibilities of a Digital Citizen.

1. Elocution Competition : Grade XI & XII

- Topic : Digital Citizenship – Our responsibility
OR
Online Risk – Content, Contact, Conduct
- Date and Date : Monday, 17th September 2018
- Duration : 3 - 5 mins
- Venue : Auditorium
- Last date for registration : Sunday, 16th September 2018

2. Presentation : Grade IX & X

- Topic : Cyber Bullying – “Nobody deserves this”

Stage 1 : A PowerPoint Presentation on the above topic is to be submitted in CD / DVD to your class teacher on or before Monday, 17th September 2018. The CD / DVD must be labelled with your 'Name' and 'Class & Div.', failing with the entry will not be accepted.



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PPT shall be evaluated on the basis of Content & Layout. Apply 'Animations' and 'Transitions' taking into consideration the viewing convenience. The topic may be conveyed in 5 - 15 slides.

Stage 2: Candidates will have to present the Short listed PPT in front of an Audience & the judges. Date of the event shall be conveyed to the selected students.

3. Poster Making Competition : Grade VII & VIII

- Topic : Be a responsible Digital Citizen
Or
Prevent Cyber Bullying
- Date and Date : Monday, 17th September 2018
- Duration : 1 hr (+10mins paint drying time)
- Venue : Respective classes
- Chart Size : (Chart paper will be provided from school)
- Stationary : All stationary / Stickers / Photographs and other items required for chart making must be brought by the Team
- Grouping : House wise (4 charts from each class)

Guidelines: The Competition will be conducted House wise in each class - One chart per house of the class. Every class will prepare 4 charts each. End of the Competition Media Club Volunteers will collect the charts from the classes. If using wet colours allow sufficient drying time (additional 10 mins will be given.)


Evaluation will be based on content, presentation and student's creativity. Mention the topic of choice on the chart. The House name must be mentioned behind the Chart.

As we prepare our children to be productive and safe citizens in their local community, let us also guide them to conduct themselves safely and responsibly in the digital world.
