Sub: Health Screening – Hearing Test, Fluoride Varnish & Dental Check-Up

As per the **MOHAP National School Health Screening Guidelines 2024**, all the students of Grade 1 are required to complete the following health screenings:

1. Hearing Screening:

- Mandatory for all Grade 1 students.
- Must be performed using an audiometer by a qualified healthcare professional.
- Purpose: Early detection of hearing problems that may affect learning.

2. Fluoride Varnish Application:

- A preventive dental treatment to strengthen teeth and prevent cavities.
- Must be done by a dentist or trained healthcare worker.

3. Dental Check-Up:

- A general oral examination to assess the child's dental and oral health.

Please note:

1. Please take your child to a certified medical center or dental clinic for all three screenings.
2. Ensure the reports clearly mention:
 - Child's name and grade and section
 - Date of examination
 - Stamp and signature of the attending doctor/dentist
3. Submit a copy of the hearing test, fluoride varnish application, and dental check-up reports to the class teacher on or before 2nd June 2026.
